Kaputei now town is being constructed using Parry technology throughout



The Trust's imposing new headquarters in the Industrial Area of Nairobi from where the finance, training and promotional activities are being directed. Originally the headquarters of Kodak East Africa, the complex is being adapted to provide comprehensive business training facilities and will have a 'banking hall' designed to handle large volumes of public deposit and withdrawal activities



Kaputei site production activities – stock of over a million rooftiles had been built up during long delays in achieving planning approval, now granted.

Over 300 houses are now roofed and are awaiting the fitting of doors, windows and internal finishing. The walls of all the houses are made from hollow concrete blocks using Parry Multivibe equipment.
